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Membership Renewals

Annual membership dues were past due on February 1. Please mail your annual dues to the mailing address at left, in order to remain a club member. Include a copy of your Concealed Carry-Handgun permit, handgun purchase permit (issued within the last three months) or an official background check with a copy of your NRA member card. IF YOU HAVE NOT COMPLETED AN ANNUAL RANGE USE AND SAFETY REVIEW MEETING IN THE PAST YEAR, you will need to submit a signed and dated waiver.

A copy of the waiver is included at the end of this newsletter.

Gate access will be denied for all nonrenewed members March 1.

March 2021

At present, the number of renewed members for 2021 may not support the general operation and maintenance of the range, clubhouse and facilities for the year. Delayed renewals are a hardship on your club and effect the ability to project future costs and prudently make repairs. The Executive Committee has discussed the implementation of late fees for dues paid after February 1 each year. Discussion also questioned whether lapsed memberships could be re-instated without penalty or complete reapplication for a new membership. These pressing issues will be on the agenda for the next member meeting, hopefully in April.

The March monthly member meeting, the range use and safety review meeting and the member matches normally held prior to the member meeting remains suspended. Hopefully we will at least be able to continue the member meeting in April outside at the picnic tables. Stay tuned.

Youth Hunter Educational Skills Tournament

WGC is proud to be the home range for two Watauga County youth teams for this state tournament.

The teams have been preparing for their annual scrimmages that are normally held each Spring. The tournament this year will be a virtual skills tournament. The virtual competition will be conducted with only one team present at a time at their home club because of Covid Restrictions.

The state will be strictly enforcing a 6-foot distance between all team members, coaches and attendees, including spectators, and everyone will be required to wear a mask. No more than 50 people total will be allowed on the range at one time. A team will be disqualified if all these protocols are not followed. WAIVER OF LIABILITY RELEASE HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

I understand that engaging in Watauga Gun Club (WGC) activities may be hazardous, with accompanying risks of personal injury, death, and/or loss or damage to my property. In consideration of my participation in such shooting activities, I, on my own behalf and that of my heirs, successors, representatives, administrators and assigns, hereby:

- 1. Waive and completely release any and all, past, present or future claims, causes of action, suits, rights, damages, costs, expenses or obligations or demands of any kind whatsoever, I, or anyone on my behalf might have against Watauga Gun Club, and its respective officers, directors, agents, representatives and contractors (together "WGC"), for any loss, damage, personal injury, death and/or loss or damage to my property resulting from my participation in such shooting activities;
- 2. Agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless WGC, from any and all claims by any person, firm, corporation or others, for any damages, loss or claims, of any nature, arising in any way out of my participation in such shooting activities; and
- **3.** Assume all risks associated with such activities and all responsibility for medical expenses, costs and/or other obligations and other losses or injuries to me or in which I may become involved, by reason of my participation in such shooting activities at the aforementioned facility and event.

I further affirm that that I am over eighteen [18] years of age, or am under the direct supervision of a person that is not disabled from possessing firearms & ammunition, and I am not a "PROHIBITED PERSON" under 18 U.S.C. 922(g), and have read and understand this Waiver of Liability and have executed this instrument voluntarily on this date.

MY COMMITMENT TO SAFE GUN HANDLING

Anyone who uses a firearm has a responsibility to themselves and others to use the firearm safely. I acknowledge that I am familiar with the basic rules of firearm safety and that those basic rules have been explained to me. I agree to follow all of the basic rules of firearm safety at all times during my use and handling of any firearms.

The safe use of firearms dictates that I understand and agree to follow all of these instructions:

- I WILL TREAT EVERY FIREARM AS IF IT WERE LOADED.
- I WILL ALWAYS KEEP THE FIREARM POINTED IN A SAFE DIRECTION.
- \bullet I WILL NOT PLACE MY FINGER ON THE TRIGGER OR IN THE TRIGGER GUARD UNLESS AND UNTIL I AM READY TO FIRE.
- I WILL ALWAYS WEAR APPROPRIATE EYE AND EAR PROTECTION.
- I WILL NEVER PASS THE FIREARM TO ANYONE WITHOUT OPENING AND KEEPING OPEN THE CYLINDER OR THE ACTION TO VERIFY THAT IT IS UNLOADED.
- \bullet I WILL ALWAYS FOLLOW THE COMMANDS OF THE RANGE OFFICER.

I understand these basic rules of firearms safety and I agree to follow them at all tir	mes. I have also within
the past 30 days reviewed and understand the WGC Range Use Manual.
