# **Range Improvements**

The decking outside the clubhouse is again in need of repair. The wood planking has rotted adjacent to the prior repairs, due to the close proximity with the soil beneath. The idea of replacing the wooden ramp with concrete is an option.

Also, the boulder on Bay 2 is again exposed and a more permanent solution to the problem of ricochet might be to remove the boulder. Options on how to accomplish this are being sought.

The parts for our entrance gate are on backorder. We are hopeful the parts and installation will happen in the very near future, but have no assurances.
